 - (1) section 137A (The FCA's general rules);
 - (2) section 137T FSMA (General supplementary powers);
 - (3) section 138D (Action for damages); and
 - (4) section 139A (Power of the FCA to give guidance).
- B. The rule-making powers listed above are specified for the purpose of section 138G(2) (Rule-making instruments) of the Act.

Commencement

C. This instrument comes into force on 28 January 2022, except for Annex B which comes into force on 29 July 2022.
